Parking Services – COVID19 Update	<p>The Cabinet Member <b>RESOLVED</b> to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Approve the continued suspension of all parking charges operating in the Council’s managed car parks and on-street parking bays.</li> <li>b) Note the summary of measures taken to both support our customers, stakeholders and partners during this un-precedented period.</li> <li>c) Note the current situation in respect of the Abandoned Vehicle, Civil Parking and Bus Lane enforcement services.</li> <li>d) Agree to receive a further update report at the scheduled decision-making session in July 2020 or in June as part of emergency decision making arrangements if the circumstances require this.</li> </ul>
Stopping-up order proposal - part of Oak Lane, Barston	<p>The Cabinet Member <b>RESOLVED</b> to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Defer the submission of an application to the magistrates court to authorise the making of a stopping-up order (to remove any historic highway status that may exist) on a disputed section of Oak Lane, Barston as shown on the attached Plan contained within Appendix A of this report until further information has been sought.</li> </ul>

Emergency Cycling and Walking Measures for COVID19 Recovery	<p>The Cabinet Member <b>RESOLVED</b> to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) Consider and approve the draft COVID19 Active Travel Strategy as set out in Appendix A,</li> <li>b) Approve, subject to successfully securing Government funding, the implementation of the 22 temporary cycling and walking schemes as detailed in Appendix B. Scheme 18 would be subject to further consultation.</li> <li>c) Agree that the schemes associated with cycling and walking set out in Appendix C, should be subject to further consultation / consideration, and</li> <li>d) Agree to receive a further update on the temporary measures at the Environment and Highways Decision-making session in September 2020</li> <li>e) Agree that officers would consult opposition spokespeople prior to the implementation or change of any temporary measures</li> </ul>
