Note the performance and financial out-turn achieved in 2019/20, as detailed in Appendix 1, and agree this information should form the basis of the annual report submitted to the Department for Transport. 2. Approve the re-introduction of the Council's Parking Tariff in all car parks where charges apply from the 1st July 2020, and support introducing measures to promote the need to use all forms of "Cashless" methods of payment to reduce the risk of further transmission of the virus, 3. Agree to resume, from 1st July 2020, enforcement of all off-street parking terms and conditions across all council managed car parks; all on-street parking restrictions including those in residential areas and bus lane contraventions in accordance with the Council's Civil Parking Enforcement powers 4. Agree to refer the Parking annual income target to the Council's budget setting process due to the projected changes being seen in shopping behaviours in the retail centres where changes currently apply, and 5. Agree to receive the next service update report at the decision-making session in November 2020
