Argument between two customers. ***** and *****. *****is calm now, Liam has offered to take ***** home. ***** has never seen or met ***** before - Liam is taking ***** home now. ***** is a little bit intoxicated. This is a verbal altercation and male is being taken home so is safeguarded. For details to be taken. I have to caller ***** ***** bn **/**/**, who has confirmed a verbal altercation ensued with one of the bar staff at the pub, stating of knowing him years ago and he had been in a fight with him to which was not true, ***** then told the male this where he was slightly annoyed, the argument ensued and ***** was then taken home by the manager Liam. ***** does not wish to make a formal complaint nor have any further dealings with this</p>

He stated that he will not return to the pub he thanked me for calling him and then hung the phone. ***** did not inform me of any threats made to him just that in recent weeks he has attended the Toby Jug where he believes that the staff/ members of public are becoming slightly annoyed at this. ***** stated that he was drunk and did have a few drinks on Saturday, and now feels sober that he is safe and well.
I informed ***** that if he does see the male again and feels H/A/D to contact the police on either 999/101. ***** has not seen the male again since Saturday and does not plan to.
