1. Purpose of Report

For information only - to advise Council of amendments to the Scheme of Delegation to Officers made by the Leader of the Council, as required under the Cabinet Procedure Rules in the Council's Constitution.

2. What is the issue?

2.1 The Leader of the Council may amend the Schemes of Delegation to Cabinet Members and Officers relating to executive functions at any time.

2.2 The Scheme of Delegation to Officers has been amended on 11th January 2021 to include the addition of delegated powers to Officers appointed by Head of Safer Communities (Regulation & Enforcement) to exercise enforcement of the following legislation:

- Cat and Dog Fur (Control of Import, Export and Placing on the Market) (Amendment etc) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019
- Construction Products (Amendment etc) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019
- Consumer Protection (Enforcement) (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019
- Consumer Protection (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2018
- Product Safety and Metrology etc (Amendment etc) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019
- Tobacco Products and Nicotine Inhaling Products (Amendment etc.) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019

- Weighing and Measuring Equipment and Meters (amendment of Secondary Legislation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2018
