1. Purpose of Report

For information only - to advise Council of amendments to the Scheme of Delegation to Officers made by the Leader of the Council, as required under the Cabinet Procedure Rules in the Council's Constitution.

2. What is the issue?

- 2.1 The Leader of the Council may amend the Schemes of Delegation to Cabinet Members and Officers relating to executive functions at any time.
- 2.2 The Scheme of Delegation to Officers was amended on 13th December 2021 to include the addition of delegated powers to the Safer Communities (Regulation & Enforcement) Officers to enforce the Commonwealth Games legislation, which includes provisions relating to unauthorised sales of Games tickets, transport around Games' locations, and the protection of commercial rights.
- 2.3 The amended Scheme also includes delegation of powers under the Botulinum Toxin and Cosmetic Fillers (Children) Act 2021 which relates to the beauty industry.
