Public Health commissioned / provided services with current service providers



Children's

Healthy Child Programme Service (0-19 years) includes Health Visiting, Infant Feeding, Family Nurse Partnership and School Nursing provided by South Warwickshire Foundation Trust – **for every family in Solihull**

Family Weight Management - For families with children 4-16yrs, Eat Well Move More

Parenting Support - Parenting education and support including age-specific child development advice (in partnership with Solar)

Primary Care

NHS Health checks - National prevention programme aiming to reduce the risk of heart attack, stroke or developing certain forms of dementia in people aged 40-74.

Long Acting reversible contraception - coils and implants fitted & removed in general practice

Emergency hormonal contraception - free from selected pharmacies

Covid Services

Covid 19 Testing Service (for non health and care settings) Free lateral flow testing/ collection service at dedicated test centres and mobile van.

Covid 19 Contact Tracing Service Call handling for contact tracing/backward contact tracing and complex cases, database for management of Covid outbreaks

Lifestyle / wellbeing

Integrated Well Being Service - Stepped care model of behavioral change support to address lifestyle risk in target groups includes specialist interventions for Weight Management, Men's Weight Management, Stop Smoking and targeted or brief interventions for Physical Activity, Social connectivity, Healthy eating, Harmful drinking.

Substance misuse services - Solihull Integrated Addiction Services - SIAS provides holistic addiction interventions, strategies and tailored support to adults, young people and affected others within Solihull, providing early intervention, prevention, treatment and recovery

Housing Support for Vulnerable People - In addition to the main substance misuse services, SIAS provide housing support to vulnerable people service jointly commissioned with Managed Growth. Public Health fund Drug & Alcohol floating support to adult drug & alcohol users to allow them to access and sustain suitable accommodation.

Sexual health service - include testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections, all forms of contraception and advice and support. University Hospitals Birmingham

Community Advice hubs - investment in hubs to assess for lifestyle risk through screening. Solihull Winter Warmth annual campaign to support residents to stay well in winter, providing a helpline advice service & resources.

Physical Activity

Leisure Centres - Everyone Active manage the leisure offer at Tudor Grange Leisure Centre and North Solihull Sports Centre.

Active Wellbeing Hub - long term health condition exercise classes including DocSpot (exercise referral), Strong and Steady, Cancer Rehab, MS & Parkinson's, Cardiac Rehab and Better Breathers.

Gentle Activity Programme - The Step into Solihull project is a gentle exercise activity programme in Solihull which incorporates a varied range of activities including walking.

Solihull Gets Active - An inclusive activity programme for people with disabilities in Solihull.

Ping! Solihull - Ping pong tables in green spaces across Solihull, providing fun and free opportunities to be active.

Run With Us – signposting to running activity across Solihull for all ages.

Solihull Girls Can - a programme to encourage more women and girls to be more active more often within their local communities.

Solihull Active - a web portal to sport and physical activity opportunities in the Borough of Solihull.

PACT (Personal Attainment and Community Training) - a suite of training for sports clubs and volunteers across Solihull

Domestic Abuse

Specialist support for Domestic Abuse Specialist support for those affected by domestic abuse. Access to free and confidential information, advice and support. Dedicated provision for females provided by Birmingham and Solihull Women's Aid. Panahghar offering a similar service for male victims.

Employment and Skills

Employment support - Help for residents of all ages to find work or training, and support for employers who are recruiting. Employability support for young people who are at risk of becoming NEET.

Kickstart – Creating new paid jobs for unemployed young people within SCH and Council teams to increase their employability and workplace skills

Life Ready Careers Hub - helping schools and colleges to improve their career offer for young people, linking up with local businesses to help employers input into curriculum development, and workplace encounters.

Solihull Recruitment and Training Centre and Youth Hub – an outreach centre in Chelmsley Wood Shopping centre for face to face support for jobseekers, and a venue for training and recruitment events

Specialist Support – creating new paid and unpaid roles within the Council ringfenced for local residents with a Learning Disability
